**TREEHOUSE KIDS' ADVENTURE CENTER HEADQUARTERS FOR CAMP
ASPEN/SNOWMASS STARTING JUNE 2**
***New Camp Aspen/Snowmass Activities Include Cooking, Crafts, Overnight Hut
Adventures, Fly Fishing***
Lift Rides and On-mountain Activities for the General Public Begin June 7

Aspen/Snowmass, CO., May 27, 2008 – The new \$17 million Treehouse Kids' Adventure Center will be headquarters for Camp Aspen/Snowmass, a daily and weekly summer camp for children ages two-and-a-half through teens, starting June 2, 2008.

New activities include cooking and craft classes, overnight hut adventures, fly fishing and Cub Care for children ages two-and-a-half to three.

Continued activities include the Snowmass Glacier Camp, mountainboarding, mountain biking, skateboarding, paintball, horseback riding, hiking, swimming, rocket building and gondola rides up Aspen Mountain.

The Snowmass Glacier Camp, June 4-27, invites skiers and snowboarders ages six through fourteen to learn to ride boxes and rails in a terrain park built at the top of the Burlingame lift. Glacier Camp participants will ski or ride in the morning and mountainboard, skateboard or play paintball in the afternoon.

Camp Aspen/Snowmass package deals for full-time employees in the Roaring Fork Valley are available when purchased on or before June 13. These packages save a significant amount of money and can be shared amongst friends and family. Early Bird special packages are also being offered to any guest signing up for several specific programs by June 13.

In addition to Camp Aspen/Snowmass, on-mountain activities for the general public will begin on the weekends starting June 7 and daily starting June 21. The Burlingame lift will take guests to miles of trails for mountain biking, hiking and mountainboarding. Burlingame lift tickets can be bought at the Snowmass Ticket Pavilion at the end of the Snowmass Village Mall and at the Treehouse. Tickets are \$10 for adults (18-69) and \$6 for youth (13-17), children (7-12) and seniors (ages 70+). As always, children six and under ride for free as well as season passholders.

Guests can enjoy lunch at the mid-mountain Lynn Britt Cabin Thursday – Saturday, starting June 28, or take a guided tour with a naturalist from the Aspen Center for Environmental Studies (ACES).

Visitors can see breathtaking views of Snowmass on one of Snowmass' 18-hole Disc Golf courses. In fact, Snowmass remains the only ski resort in Colorado to offer two 18-hole Disc Golf courses.

Paintball and trout fishing are also offered.

Four-Mountain Sports/D&E Ski and Snowboard Shop in the Snowmass Village Mall will have mountain bikes, mountainboards and golf discs available for rent.

The Treehouse Kids' Adventure Center, located in the new Snowmass base village, opened with success this past Thanksgiving, November 22, 2007. Parents and children alike have raved over the 25,000-square-foot facility with six age-specific interactive nature-themed rooms.
