- **Cultural:** Artistic flair meets nineteenth century charm at the internationally-renowned Anderson Ranch Arts Center, which blends the warm, inspired feel of a true artists' commune with historic ranch buildings and spectacular gardens. - **Outdoor/Scenic Mountain Venue:** Snowmass' spectacular mountain vistas provide the perfect backdrop for any event. The **Lynn Britt Cabin**, an elegantly rustic log cabin on Snowmass Mountain, features panoramic views of the mountains. This historic cabin has indoor seating for 65 and can accommodate up to 250 guests (with additional equipment rentals). Amenities include on-site catering, and assistance with floral, entertainment, photographers and videographers, transportation, and more. (800.525.6200 x 4715; 970.923.8715). The **Snowmass Rodeo Grounds** combine the authentic feel of the old west with an old-fashioned family picnic and is host to the historic Snowmass Rodeo on Wednesday evenings during the summer. Catering is available and covered seating for up to 200 people make this the perfect Western wedding locale (970.923.8898; www.snowmassrodeo.org). The **new Snowmass soccer field and gazebo** right next door are available for rent to private parties and boast spectacular mountain views (970.922.2240 or www.snowmassrecreation.com).
- Tucked away in a secluded wooded area on the slopes of Snowmass Mountain is the **Krabloonik Restaurant and Kennel**. This hidden wintertime gem is headquarters to Snowmass' famed sled dogs and Krabloonik Restaurant with its world-class cuisine in a rustic setting. The log cabin seats up to 90 people and offers stunning views of Mt. Daly and Capitol Peak. Ideal for a romantic and intimate winter wedding (970.923.3953 x0; www.krabloonik.com). **Informal Outdoor/Scenic Settings:** Looking for a more casual locale? Stunning, natural outdoor settings abound. The Maroon Bells, one of the most photographed ranges in the country, is easily accessible, while the Ditch and Rim Trails and local Snowmass parks offer spectacular opportunities for a photographic "I do."
- **Indoor/Outdoor Mixed-Use:** The newly remodeled, **Stonebridge Inn** offers 3,200 square feet of flexible event space and private dining/party options including adjoining

outdoor decks. This romantic, relaxed setting in the heart of Snowmass offers mouth-watering menu options from the on-site restaurant The Artisan and can serve parties of up to 200 people. Vaulted ceilings, natural light, fireplace and adjoining outdoor sundeck, pool and hot tub areas are ideal for indoor/outdoor entertainment. - **Luxury/Full-Service:** The luxurious **Snowmass Club** offers a variety of indoor and outdoor spaces to accommodate diverse wedding functions. This four-star mountain resort includes the finest Colorado cuisine at the on-site restaurant Sage, country club amenities such as golf, tennis, and a full-service athletic club and spa, and stunning views of Mt. - **A Grand Affair:** The **Silvertree Hotel and Conference Center** is the ideal location for events and weddings on a grander scale. - The **Viceroy Snowmass**, a 236-room hotel located in the new \$1 billion base village development, is slated to open Winter 09/10 and will soon offer guests a variety of unparalleled mountain resort amenities including a 5,000 square foot spa, 15,000 square feet of conference space, fitness center, dedicated meeting and event space, casual and fine dining restaurants, and more.
