Vintage Porsche Auto Show heads to Snowmass Sept. 6



(Snowmass Village). Snowmass Village is offering the opportunity to check out some hot cars at the coolest mountain resort. Vintage Porsches will gather at the Two Creeks Lift Area on Wednesday, September 6, 2006 and the public is invited to come check out these lean, mean, driving machines.

Approximately 150 cars will be displayed from 10:00 AM until 2:00 PM. The cars will be the

Type 356 (three-fifty-six) Porsche, first manufactured in Gmund, Austria, in 1948 with production moving to Stuttgart, Germany in 1950. Production of the 356 Model ceased in 1965, when the now-familiar 911 (nine-eleven) model was introduced. The cars you will see are the first automobiles to carry the Porsche name and are called "356," as that was their design number.

Porsches will come from all over the U.S. and will include some of the finest examples in existence of this unique automobile. The cars will be judged for their condition and originality. There will be a trophy presentation in the afternoon. A grilled lunch will be available for a small charge.

The show is part of a "Holiday" event hosted by the Rocky Mountain 356 Porsche Club and the group is staying at the Silvertree Hotel in Snowmass. On Thursday, September 7, the same 150 Porsches will drive through Aspen and over Independence Pass to Steamboat, where the event will conclude on Sunday, September 10. So come see check out these beautiful vintage Porsche 356s, the grandfathers of the modern Icon that everyone recognizes as simply, "a Porsche".
