Jazz Aspen Snowmass Announces Side Stage & JAS After Dark Performances

Aspen, CO -- August 20, 2007 – As if the Jazz Aspen Snowmass Labor Day Festival main stage acts weren't enough, JAS has announced supporting acts taking place daily on two side stages along with JAS After Dark shows following the headlining performances each night.

The JAS Music Club has become a popular gathering area before and in between main festival acts. Up and coming bands keep the audience dancing and will be no exception this year with the following performances: Friday, American blues/roots artist Peter Karp; Saturday, singer/songwriter Ryan Shaw; Sunday, Georgia-based quintet, Tishamingo and Monday, New York quintet Ollabelle.

On the other side of the field during intermissions? In addition to outstanding food, creative crafts and the kids corner you will find in the JAS Village, you will also be treated to some great live music. The JAS Village stage will feature the following: Friday, progressive rock from Nothing More; Saturday Nashville's Shake Go Home; Sunday, Leftover Salmon's Vince Herman joins his newest project, Great American Taxi; and Monday, rocking blues from Big Daddy Lee & the Kingbees.

When the music stops at the festival site JAS After Dark keeps the party going with performances in Snowmass (The Artisan, Cirque & Mountain Dragon) and Aspen (Belly Up). Jes Grew, Peter Karp, Nothing More, Elemenopee,

Tishamingo, Shake Go Home, DJ Z-Trip, Great American Taxi and Ollabelle will all take a stage. All shows start at 10pm. For more details visit www.jazzaspen.org.
