Nine years ago a car accident left Deb Lewin brain damaged, paralyzed, and with impaired sight and hearing. She calls this her "Opportunity." Today, a national equestrian champion and sought after motivational speaker, Deb is committed to providing tools that turn losses into wins and problems into possibilities.

This feature length documentary draws us into the life-changing experiences of ordinary people who understand the challenge of defeating fears, gaining clarity of purpose and taking life-changing risks. These individuals reveal how fearful situations offer the opportunity for all of us to choose whether to become victims or to creatively redefine our lives.

Along with Deb, the documentary features Amanda Boxtel, a paraplegic, motivational speaker and co-founder of the largest adaptive winter sports program in the world.

Fast paced action shots; beautifully crafted visuals and film dramatizations complement the powerful narrative. Internationally recognized spiritual leaders, including Dr. Richard Moss, provide an insight into the mystery and depth of these and other remarkable engaging people.
